

Basic adult prices at Wollongong Memorial Gardens and cemeteries operated by Wollongong City Council

Category 1 and 2 cemetery and crematoria operators in NSW are required to provide you their basic (least expensive) prices for basic adult burial, ash interment and cremation in this specific format. This is to help you understand how prices are structured, compare options presented by the operator, compare between operators, *and ultimately make informed decisions.*

Please note that operators are also required to publish prices for all of their available interment services, either on their website or at their premises.

Key terms

Term	Explanation
Interment right	Gives the 'interment right holder' (normally the person making plans and signing paperwork) the exclusive right to a specific place for burial or ashes (an 'interment site'), either permanently ('perpetual tenure') or for a defined period ('renewable tenure'). Operators set this price based on factors such as administration costs (e.g. preparing paperwork), the cost of land, and maintenance costs.
Interment	The placement of human remains (bodily remains via burial or cremated remains via ash interment) below ground or in above ground structures. Operators set this price based on factors like preparation costs (e.g. excavation), staff time and administration costs (e.g. preparing paperwork). If an external party conducts the interment, there may be a separate cost.
Cremation	A process for the reduction of bodily remains, usually by fire or heat. Operators set this price based on factors such as administrative costs (e.g. preparing paperwork), operating costs of the facility and any additional services (e.g. collection, storage, transportation).
Additional fees and charges	Only noted where fees and charges are mandatory for this basic service type.

Relationship between these prices and prices charged

This document ensures you are aware of the least expensive option available to you. You can choose other options, that may be more expensive.

Whatever you choose, you must be provided with a consumer contract in relation to that service which will contain the price broken down in the same way as these basic prices.

This will make it easy to compare the service you choose with the least expensive service.
